

## Phlebotomy

Required Steps to Obtain	1.	Students must successfully complete all requirements for WDT's Phlebotomy Program. Register with American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP) to begin the certification process. Requirements are found at: <u>www.ascp.org/certification</u>

	2.	Determine an eligibility route (Route 1 or 2), complete the online application process, and submit the application fee.
	3.	Submit required documentation for verification of eligibility. Forms for eligibility must be obtained from Program Director.
		Note: ASCP must receive official high school transcripts prior to receiving certification.
	4.	Receive approval to take the computerized exam at a Pearson Professional Center within a 3-month period upon exam eligibility.
	5.	Schedule the exam at the Pearson Professional Center of your choice.
		NOTE: A preliminary pass/fail result will be provided at the end of exam
	6.	Receive email notification to log in and view the final exam score report.
		NOTE: Certificate will be sent approximately 4-8 weeks after receiving passing score report
	7.	Maintaining the Certification - Initial certification is valid for 3 years. The Credential Maintenance Program is required every three years to maintain certification.
		NOTE: If you plan to work outside of South Dakota, you will be required to apply for registration and/or licensure within that state. Each state may have different requirements for this process.
