

## WDT Grading Scales

1. WDT has 2 approved grading scales.

A	90-100	A	94-100
B	80-89	B	87-93
C	70-79	C	79-86
D	60-69	D	73-78
F	0-59	F	0-72

2. If students are required to earn a certain percentage or to earn a certain letter grade to pass a course, that requirements must be included on the instructor syllabi for the 2014-2015 academic year. As of 2015-2016, the requirement must be included in the WDT Catalog.

Example 1 - If a non-Gen Ed course requires a “C” or better to pass, the faculty member needs to put the requirement on the instructor syllabus, and the grading scale would then be modified on the syllabus to read as stated below.

A – 94 to 100    B – 87 to 93    C – 79 to 86    F – 0 to 78

Example 2 - If a non-Gen Ed course requires an 85% or better to pass, the faculty member needs to put the requirement on the instructor syllabus, and the grading scale would then be modified on the syllabus to read as stated below.

A – 94 to 100    B – 87 to 93    C – 85 to 86    F – 0 to 84
