**Course Title:** Technology in Law Enforcement  
**Credits:** 2  
**Contact Hours:** 2 Lecture

**Course Description:** This course is designed to introduce students to the use of various pieces of equipment and tools that are available to law enforcement officers in today's society. When appropriate, students will certify in the use of the equipment and tools. Students will learn GPS/GIS, TASER, RADAR, LIDAR, and forensic mapping utilizing a total station data collection and associated software. Additional technology will be integrated into the class as science provides updated and innovative equipment to the world of law enforcement.
