4. <i>Technology Skills</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply technology skills gained in electrical trades by identifying the correct technology for solving problems, communicating using technology (Blue Beam/Email), and recognizing the impact of technology on electricians.</li> </ul>
5. <i>Teamwork Techniques</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Demonstrate teamwork techniques in the electrical industry by working collaboratively with others, resolving conflicts as a team, and demonstrating equal participation in a team setting.</li> </ul>
