<i>Life Skills</i>	<p>Safety</p> <p>The PN student will demonstrate safety measures and minimize the risk of harm to patients and providers by engaging in system effectiveness and applying individual safety measures.</p>
<i>Analytic Techniques</i>	<p>Quality Improvement</p> <p>The PN student will improve the quality and safety of health care systems by evaluating data to monitor the outcomes of care processes and using improvement methods to design and test changes.</p>
<i>Communication Skills</i>	<p>Communication</p> <p>The PN student will demonstrate effective communication skills by practicing therapeutic communication, practicing active listening, and utilizing appropriate terminology.</p>
<i>Technology Skills</i>	<p>Informatics</p> <p>The PN student will employ informatics to communicate with care teams, manage knowledge, mitigate error, and support decision-making.</p>
<i>Teamwork Techniques</i>	<p>Teamwork and Collaboration</p> <p>The PN student will demonstrate teamwork and collaboration by functioning effectively within nursing and inter-professional teams, engaging in open communication and mutual respect, and applying shared decision-making to achieve quality patient care.</p>
<i>Social Values</i>	<p>Patient-Centered Care</p> <p>The PN student will be able to provide patient-centered care by recognizing the patient as a source of control and full partner in providing compassionate and coordinated care based on respect for patient's preferences, values, and needs.</p>
<i>Employability</i>	<p>Evidence-Based Practice</p> <p>The PN student will deliver optimal health care by integrating best current evidence with clinical expertise, and integrating evidence-based practice with patient/family preferences and values.</p>
