Required Steps to Obtain Your Credential	1. Successfully complete the primary eligibility pathway for radiography for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT)
	2. Submit required documentation for verification of eligibility, including ethical verification
	3. Sit for the Radiography Technologist (RT) Exam
	4. Certification exam results are documented by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) and a copy is sent to the applicant
	<p>5. Maintaining the credential – Credential maintenance is required every year to maintain certification and registration. Biannual continuing education (CE) requirements are needed to keep certification current and every 10 years there will be a continuing qualifications requirement (CQR).</p> <p><i>NOTE: Currently, there are no licensure requirements for the state of South Dakota. If you plan to work outside of South Dakota, you will be required to apply for registration and/or licensure within that state. Each state may have different requirements for this process.</i></p>
