Required Steps to Obtain Your Credential	Successfully complete all requirements for WDTC's Registered Dental Assisting Program
	 2. Complete the RDA Application on the South Dakota Dental Board website by submitting the following: a. The required fee b. A copy of your birth certificate (applicant must be at least 18 years old) c. A copy of your current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) card. The Board accepts only the American Heart Association for the Basic Life Support Provider (BLS) or the American Red Cross for Basic Life Support (BLS) d. Proof of successful completion of WDTC's Expanded Functions Dental Assistant course e. If applicable, documentation of any name change (i.e. marriage license) f. If applicable, a verification letter from each state in which you are or have been registered
	 3. Complete the RDA Dental Radiographer Application on the South Dakota Dental Boardwebsite by submitting the following: a. The required fee b. A copy of your government-issued identification card c. Proof of successful completion of WDTC's Radiography courses d. If applicable, documentation of any name change (i.e. marriage license) e. If applicable, a verification letter from each state in which you are or have been registered
