PROHIBITED DISCLOSURES OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

Western Dakota Technical College (WDTC) will not disclose personally identifiable information obtained in the course of complying with Policy 4420 Pregnancy and Related Conditions – Students, except in the following circumstances:

1. When WDTC has obtained prior written consent from the student to the disclosure;
2. When the information is disclosed to a parent, guardian, or other authorized legal representative with the legal right to receive disclosures on behalf of the student whose personally identifiable information is at issue;
3. To carry out the purposes of Policy 4420, including action taken to address conduct that reasonably may constitute sex discrimination under Title IX in WDTC's education program or activity;
4. As required by Federal law, Federal regulations, or the terms and conditions of a Federal award, including a grant award or other funding agreement; or
5. To the extent such disclosures are not otherwise in conflict with Title IX or Policy 4420, when required by State or local law or when permitted under FERPA, 20 U.S.C. 1232g, or its implementing regulations, 34 CFR part 99.

NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATION

WDTC does not discriminate on the basis of sex and prohibits sex discrimination in any education program or activity that it operates, as required by Title IX, including in admissions and employment.
