HOW MUCH DOES OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING COST STUDENTS?

Double Occupancy \$2,850 per semester* Single Occupancy \$5,700 per semester* *23-24 rates subject to change

CAN STUDENTS STAY IN HOUSING DURING SCHOOL BREAKS?

Yes! The lease is for the entire academic year. Move-in/out dates are usually the weekend before classes start and weekend after classes end.

WHERE ARE THE APARTMENTS LOCATED?

The apartments are located 4 miles from the campus at 2401 Mt. Rushmore Rd.

CAN I USE FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS TO PAY FOR HOUSING?

The Build Dakota Scholarship does not cover housing. However, if you have Financial Aid or other scholarships available after paying for tuition and fees, it may be used for housing.

WHAT FACILITIES & AMENITIES ARE INCLUDED?

The off-campus housing units are fully furnished with beds, bedding, living & dining furniture, televisions, some kitchen dishes, towels & hangers.
